NEVADA GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Millennium Scholarship

Eligible Millennium Scholars must be **enrolled full-time (12 or more credits)** in a Nevada college or university to receive the \$60 per credit award. Tuition may be funded for up to 15 credits per semester. Remedial courses are not eligible for funding, but will count toward the full-time enrollment requirement. Silver State Opportunity Grant Program

The SSOG Program was established by the Nevada Legislature to provide grants to **eligible low-income students** within the Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE) (UNLV excluded). Limited funds are awarded to students enrolled in 15 or more credits on a semester basis according to a formula established by the NSHE Board of Regents. Students should complete the FAFSA in order to be considered for this award.

TheDream.US National Scholarship NSC is the only school in Nevada to offer this national scholarship for High School and Community College Graduates. This scholarship covers tuition and fees up to a maximum of \$25,000 for a bachelor's degree. The Award is renewable each year for those who meet the continuing eligibility criteria – including continuous full-time enrollment (more than 12 credits per term) and a college GPA of 3.0.

Scorpion Academic Scholarship Program, GPA as follows: 3.75+ \$2,500 semester, 3.5-3.74 \$1,500
Eligible students graduate from HS w/ minimum 3.25 unweighted GPA, or from community college within NSHE with a 3.25 GPA and an AA, AS, AB, or AAS in Nursing. Students must enroll as a full-time (12+ credits), degree-seeking student the semester immediately following graduation. Freshman may qualify to receive award during first eight fall or spring semesters of their enrollment, transfer students during the first four.

Transfer Scholarship NSC will award a one-time \$1,000 scholarship to students transferring from a NSHE community college with an AA, AB, or AS degree, a minimum 2.75 GPA and who are not awarded under the Scorpion Scholars Merit Scholarship Program. Students must have met the priority deadline, and enroll as a full-time (12 or more credits), degree-seeking student to receive the award.

Leadership Scholarship NSC will award a one-time \$1,000 scholarship to new freshman students in their first semester of enrollment who served as an officer in their high school student government, are admitted by the priority deadline with a 2.75 unweighted cumulative high school GPA and who enroll as a full-time (12 or more credits), degree-seeking student. Students should notify NSC of their eligibility at the time of application to the College.

Matching Scholarship NSC will provide a match of up to \$500 per semester to students who receive a scholarship from an outside agency (excludes any scholarships awarded by NSC, NSHE or the State of Nevada).

CSN DREAM Scholarship This is a scholarship inspired by DREAMers. It seeks to help any students planning to enroll in at least six credits per semester with a 2.5 GPA. Recipients will be selected based on their ability to meet requirements, letters of recommendation, involvement in the community and/or CSN, and a personal statement.
